We are here for you and your pet. This contract is written for the protection of the breeders and buyer(s). More importantly, it is primarily written to protect the health and well-being of the puppy.

Purchase Agreement

- ❖ Please read the full purchase agreement and health guarantee, before putting a deposit on a puppy. By choosing to put a deposit on a puppy, you are agreeing to the terms and conditions of this contract.
- ❖ A minimum \$200 deposit is required to hold the puppy of your choice. The deposit can only be made in cash, by PayPal or Venmo payment, or credit card.
- ❖ This deposit is non-refundable, unless there is a problem with the health of your puppy. In that case, the buyer(s) will have a choice of receiving a full refund or transferring the deposit to another puppy.

Please be certain that you are ready for the time commitment and financial responsibility of owning a puppy, before giving us a deposit.

Health Guarantee

- ❖ It will ultimately be up to us, the breeders, to decide when a puppy is ready to leave our home. Normally a puppy is ready to go at the age of eight weeks. This will all be dependent on how well the puppy is weaned from its mother, its weight and it's overall health. We will not, under any circumstances, let a puppy leave our home before we feel it is ready. We, the breeders, may require a daily fee for any puppy kept longer than eight weeks, at the request of the buyer(s).
- ❖ The puppy will be up-to-date on its vaccine(s) and dewormings, at the time of pick up. It is very important that you continue the vaccination and deworming. Please do not expose your puppy to other dogs, that are not fully vaccinated, until it has completed the entire vaccination schedule. Normally this is around 16-20 weeks of age.
- ❖ The puppy will have been vet checked, and deemed healthy, before it leaves our home.
- ❖ The puppy is guaranteed to be in good health at the time of sale.
- ❖ The buyer(s) is/are required to have the puppy examined, by a Licensed Vet, within 72 hours of receiving the puppy. The buyer(s) is/are responsible for this expense. If this requirement is not fulfilled, this Health Guarantee is null and void.
- ❖ Documentation from the vet exam must be sent to the breeders, within five days of the visit, in order for the Health Guarantee to be honored.
- ❖ If within the 72 hours, a Licensed Vet finds the puppy to have an undiscovered congenital defect, the puppy may be returned and another puppy will be offered, when available – provided the puppy has not been injured nor neglected. The veterinarian must provide a written statement deeming the puppy unfit for purchase.
- ❖ The guarantee is null and void if any health issues are caused by injury or neglect by the buyer(s).
- ❖ This guarantee does not cover minor illnesses and health issues, i.e. colds, allergies, internal or external parasites, prolapsed eyelids, or hernias. These issues can be caused by too many variables, besides genetics. The breeders will disclose any known illness(es) or health issue(s), prior to the sale.
- ❖ The breeders will not assume responsibility for this puppy, after the sale. It is the responsibility of the buyer(s) to properly care for the puppy and keep it from harm.
- ❖ The breeders assume no responsibility for any medical expenses, incurred after the sale.
- ❖ The breeders do not guarantee size. We can provide the weights of the puppy's parents and littermates, upon request. We can give the buyer(s) an educated guess as to the full grown weight, but we find that there are too many variables, besides genetics.
- ❖ The breeders do not guarantee fertility, ability to breed or ability to place in shows. The puppy is strictly sold as a High Quality Pet. _____
- ❖ The breeders give a One-Year Guarantee against congenital defects of the puppy. If it is determined, by a Licensed Vet, that the puppy suffers from a congenital defect, not mentioned above, then the puppy will be returned to the breeders and the buyer(s) will receive another puppy, when one is available. NO Refunds Will Be Given.
